The Technology

TjopTjop is a mobile digital screening app which assists with mandatory health screening, digitized record keeping and provides a dashboard display with results for data analysis.

TjopTjop is affordable, easy to use, and an allin-one Covid-19 health screening solution for schools and businesses.

The app requires that each person authorised to enter a particular property be issued with a QR code as an identification token, and that all points of entry are issued with a smart phone (loaded with the TjopTjop app) and a digital thermometer.

No pen or paper required.

Cloud storage, POPI compliant.

Easy, real time viewer access and report extraction by institution.

Health questionnaires can, by request be customised remotely.

Available from Apple and Android online stores.

Reasonable rates: From as low as R20 per month for ECD centres.

Market Opportunity

Ideal for schools and businesses during Covid-19. Further potential developments for post-Covid include:

- Smart queueing: for businesses and government departments
- School tuck shop payment/ debit card
- Parcel and scholar delivery tracking

The app currently scans 25,000 people per day in SA, without serious marketing effort.
