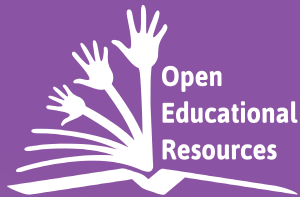


What are Open Educational Resources (OER)?



William and Flora Hewlett Foundation (2018):
“teaching, learning and research materials in any medium – digital or otherwise – that reside in the public domain or have been released under an open license that permits no-cost access, use, adaptation and redistribution by others with no or limited restrictions”.

What can be considered OER?

Full courses, course materials, modules, textbooks, streaming videos, tests, software and any other tools, materials or techniques in support of the access to knowledge (Arinto et al., 2017, DHET, 2017).

Creative Commons licences

Attribution license or “CC BY” allows people to use the work for any purpose (even commercially and even in modified form) as long as they give attribution to the creator.



Attribution-ShareAlike license or “BY-SA” allows people to use the work for any purpose (even commercially and even in modified form), as long as they give attribution to the creator and make any adaptations they share with others available under the same or a compatible license.



Attribution-NonCommercial license or “BY-NC” allows people to use the work for non-commercial purposes only, and only as long as they give attribution to the creator.



Attribution-NonCommercial-ShareAlike license or “BY-NC-SA” allows people to use the work for non-commercial purposes only, and only as long as they give attribution to the creator and make any adaptations they share with others available under the same or a compatible license.



Attribution-NoDerivatives license or “BY-ND” allows people to use the unadapted work for any purpose (even commercially), as long as they give attribution to the creator.



Attribution-NonCommercial-NoDerivatives license or “BY-NC-ND” is the most restrictive license offered by CC. It allows people to use the unadapted work for non-commercial purposes only, and only as long as they give attribution to the licensor.
