eFundi Tutorial: Web Content



The Web Content tool allows Instructors to create a link to a web site in the Tool Menu of the site. By default, the link will open within your eFundi site but you can change the settings that allows the website to be opened in a new window. You can make use of internal or external websites.

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

How to add Web Content to your site

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Go to Site Info on your module site and select the Manage Tools tab.



Select the checkbox next to the Web content tool and click on the Continue button.

You can give the Web content tool a **title** which will appear in the Menu toolbar. You need to type in the website address in the **Source** textbox.




How to view Web Content on your site

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Go to the new Web Content tool on the Tool Menu of your site. The website will be displayed inside your site by default.

Note: The name displayed is the title that you gave the website when creating the tool.



How to edit Web Content on your site

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You can update the website link and settings after creating the tool. Go to the **Web Content** tool on the Tool Menu of your site. Click on the **Edit** button on the top-right of the website window.

- 1. Type here to change the name that displays in the Toolbar Menu.
- 2. Type here to change the name that displays on top of the website window.
- 3. Select the drop-down list to change the icon that displays in the Toolbar Menu.
- 4. Select the drop-down list to adjust the height of the website window but the default is set to optimally display the website.
- 5. Type here to change the URL of the website.
- 6. Select the checkbox if you would prefer that the website opens in a new tab in your browser.

Click on Update Options to save your changes.

Using internal and external websites in Web Content

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You can make the Web Content tool display an external site, such as <u>www.google.com</u> or you can display an internal tool, such as a folder in your site's Resources.

To display an external site, simply visit the website and copy the URL.
