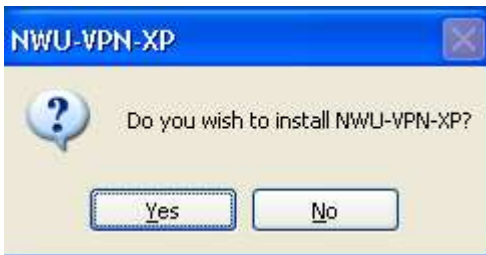


Limited VPN Windows XP Installation Guide

1 Setup procedure

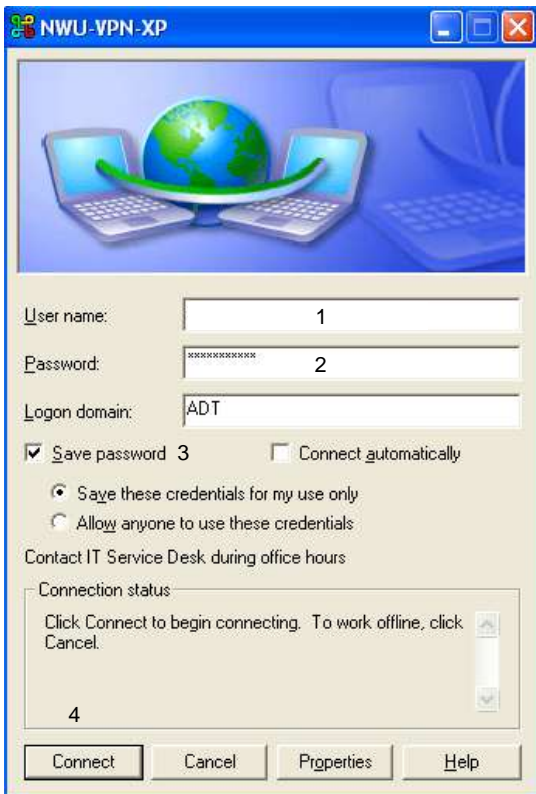
- From within a browser window (Internet Explorer or Firefox) type the following URL: <ftp://ftp.puk.ac.za/outgoing/Limited-VPN> and download **NWU-Xp.exe**.
- Run the downloaded file to install. The following prompt will appear:



- Select **Yes** to continue. The following is displayed. Make choices as shown and click **Ok** to finish the installation.



The following will be displayed:



1. **User name:** Type your NWU number.
2. **Password:** Type your Network password.
3. **Save password:** By selecting this option, you will need to re-enter your password every time your Network password expires.
4. Click on **Connect** to make a connection.

2 Making a connection after setup completion

Remember, you need an Internet connection before making a connection via the VPN. Make sure you are connected to the Internet first.

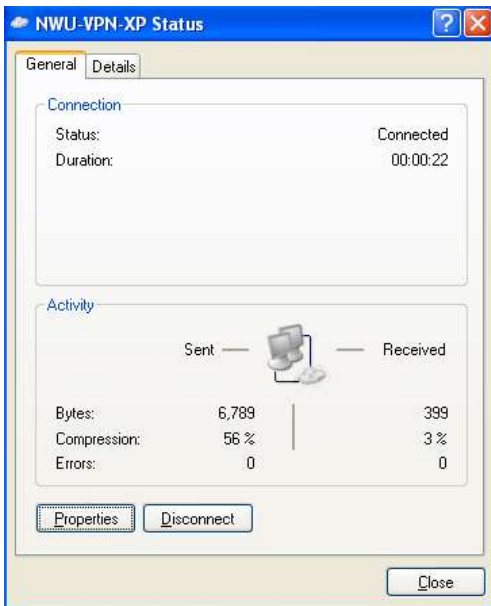
The icon on the Desktop (if you chose to install it during installation) will look as follows and can be used to connect to the VPN service:



Connect with the same information as shown above.

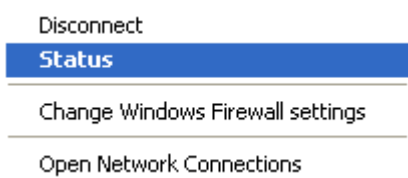
Once connected a network icon  will be visible in the System tray.

- Click it to display more options.



From here you can **Disconnect** as well.

If you Right click on the icon in the System tray you can also choose **Disconnect** from the list:



3 Browser Configuration for Automatic Proxy

It is recommended to browse through **Internet Explorer** as any non-proxy configuration (which is usually the default) will be automatically set for auto-proxy during the VPN connection. If making use of another browser, make sure you proxy settings are set for "auto-detect".
