Tips



eFundi is a powerful tool that you have at your disposal. All you need to do is use it effectively! Below are some tips that might help to improve your students' and your own experience.

Tips:

- * Need some help to get started using a new tool? Check out our **eFundi VTC Training 2016** site on eFundi for tutorials and help files.
- * Include **rubrics** when posting an assignment or forum. This will make it easier for students to understand how they are going to be graded and what you expect from them.
- * Provide question level **feedback** to students in your Tests & Quizzes, even if it is just to tell them where in the textbook they will find the correct answer.
- * Encourage students to install the **eFundi Move app** on their mobile devices so they get instant notifications when you post an announcement or upload a new resource.
- * Use the **Chat room** as an office with office hours when you cannot be on campus.
- * Distribute grades via **Gradebook** to ensure students know the current status of their grades and can inform you if there are any mistakes or problems.
