2. Evaluations or survey results from participants regarding the event/course/workshop/conference.

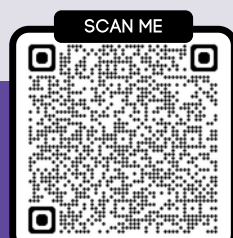

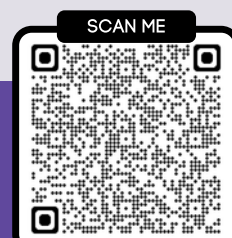

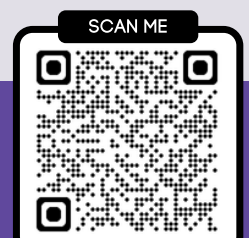
