Register your modules

You will receive an email with a registration link that you must complete to let us know which modules you are lecturing for the current semester.

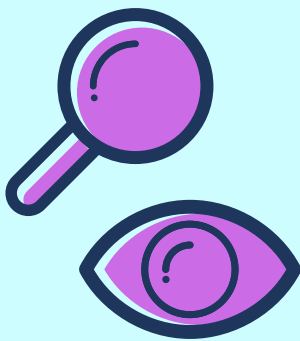


STEP 02

You will receive each module link in a separate email.

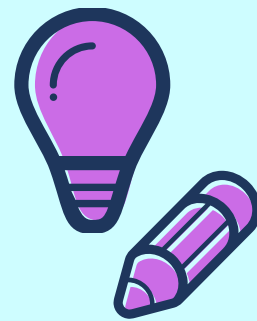
