

1 IMPORTANT NOTICE: NWU-Guest Wi-Fi phasing out

Please note that the current NWU-Guest Wi-Fi service will be phased out and discontinued on 31 January 2026.

2 What this means for visitors

The NWU-Visitor Wi-Fi is the designated wireless service for guests and visitors to the university.

Access is provided via a self-registration captive portal when connecting to the NWU-Visitor SSID.

Visitors will have access for a period of three days.

This service is strictly for visitors and guests.

NB!!! NWU staff and students may not use the NWU-Visitor Wi-Fi and must continue to connect to the appropriate institutional networks, such as NWUWIFI.

3 International visitors







Visitors from institutions that participate in [eduroam](#) can connect to the eduroam SSID on any NWU campus using their home institution credentials.

If a visitor's institution does not participate in [eduroam](#), or if the visitor is not affiliated with an institution, a building representative may log a request with the IT Helpdesk.

The [IT Helpdesk](#) will create an eduroam visitor account for the duration of the visit, where required.
