



## TAKE NOTE: CITRIX EXTENSION TO PC LABS

### What is it about?

Citrix – a Desktop Virtualization platform used by the NWU – has been available to staff and students since April 2020 and continually improved through user feedback. The strategic goal of Citrix is twofold: firstly, to provide convenient, anywhere, anytime access on almost any device, and secondly, to extend the life of physical PC labs by offloading demanding computing tasks to a central system more capable than the individual workstations. To achieve the second goal, NWU-IT has recently rolled out Citrix-only images to some physical PC labs on the Potchefstroom campus, with labs on the other campuses to follow soon.

### What do the users need to take note of?

Users logging into these labs will automatically be directed into a session on the *All-purpose Lab Desktop*, which is pre-loaded with most of the software licensed by the NWU. Working in a Virtual Desktop environment might take some getting used to at first. Still, there are advantages, such as saving files in your *Documents* folder, which will transfer between sessions, even allowing you to continue working later at home or on the move.

### How will it affect the user?

Users need to be aware that things such as using external devices like flash-drives might not work the same as you are used to on your physical device and they may need to take additional steps to use such devices.

Users can refer to the Citrix IT Service Catalogue entry for more information on getting started with Citrix on their own devices, as well as using the environment.
