

## INTERNET ACCESS FOR GUESTS

### 1 NWU-Visitor Wi-Fi setup while awaiting full access

#### 1.1 Overview

NWU-Visitor Wi-Fi provides temporary internet access to visitors, guests, and users awaiting full NWU access. This page explains how to register on the NWU-Visitor Wi-Fi network, retrieve the temporary access details, and sign in successfully.

#### 1.2 Before you start

- Ensure that Wi-Fi is switched on in your device.
- Select the NWU-Visitor wireless network from the available Wi-Fi networks.
- Use an email address that you can access, as your Wi-Fi credentials will be sent to that address.
- Follow the registration and sign-in steps below in order.

### 2 Quick setup steps

Start with Step 1 below to register and get connected. The process includes registering, receiving your credentials by email, and signing in with them.

Step	Action	Instruction text for the Service Catalogue
<a href="#">STEP 1</a>	<b>Connect to NWU-Visitor</b>	Open the Wi-Fi settings on your device, then select the NWU-Visitor network.
<a href="#">STEP 2</a>	<b>Complete the registration form</b>	Enter the required details on the registration page and click Register.
<a href="#">STEP 3</a>	<b>Confirm that registration is complete</b>	Wait for the registration confirmation screen to display before continuing.
<a href="#">STEP 4</a>	<b>Check your email</b>	Open your email inbox and look for the Wi-Fi access details sent to the address you used during registration.
<a href="#">STEP 5</a>	<b>View your Wi-Fi credentials</b>	Note the username and password, or the temporary Wi-Fi credentials, provided in the email.
<a href="#">STEP 6</a>	<b>Return to the sign-in page</b>	Go back to the NWU-Visitor Wi-Fi sign-in page to continue.
<a href="#">STEP 7</a>	<b>Sign in</b>	Enter the Wi-Fi credentials received by email and log in.
<a href="#">STEP 8</a>	<b>Confirm successful sign-in</b>	When the sign-in is complete, your device should be connected to the internet via NWU-Visitor Wi-Fi.
